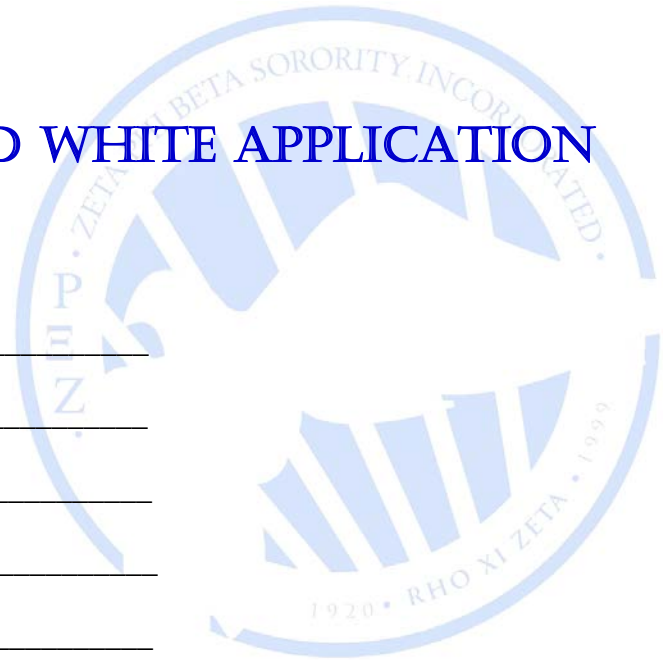
In order for your child to participate, the packet must be completed in its entirety and accompanied by the non-refundable application fee and parental/guardianship consent no later than April 17th.
