Thank you for your interest in the Lillian Plato Scholarship Award given in honor of the grandmother of one of our very own Nicole Deas, ZEAL Foundation Board Member and charter member of Rho Xi Zeta Chapter.

In order for you to apply, you must meet the following criteria:

- ❖ Must be an active member for at least 1 year in the Rho Xi Zeta Chapter Archonette Auxiliary Group or 2 years overall.
- ❖ Must be a female presently enrolled as a high school graduating senior
- ❖ Must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher at the time of the application deadline and at the end of the 2017-2018 school year.
- ❖ Should be a responsible, supportive, and positive individual who is interested in servicing the community.
- ❖ Must have applied to any Accredited College or University (2 year or 4 year programs).

Please make sure that the following forms and documents are submitted:

- ❖ COMPLETED 2018 Lillian Plato Scholarship Award Application
- ❖ Scholarship Essay (500-800 words)
- ❖ Official copy of high school transcript. Please scan and/or attachment and submit with application as one compressed file
- ❖ Two letters of recommendations: Letters should be typed and printed on letterhead. Please scan and/or attach and submit with application as one compressed file
 - One letter should be submitted on your behalf from a local member of the community and/or an active member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. to support your service and character within your community
 - The second letter should be submitted on your behalf from a faculty or staff member from your school who can support your academic performance and overall character as a student

Once we receive your completed packet (application, essay, transcript, and two letters of recommendations) you will receive a confirmation email. Incomplete or late packets will not be accepted! NO EXCEPTIONS! After applications are received, applicants will be assigned points based on the following information:

- ❖ Recommendation Letters
- ❖ Scholarship Essay
- ❖ Overall Presentation
- ❖ Grade Point Average

Scholarship Rules and Guidelines

In order to be eligible to receive the 2018 Lillian Plato Scholarship Award the following rules apply:

1. Must be member of a Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., Rho Xi Zeta Chapter Archonette Youth Auxiliary and an active member for at least 1 year or overall 2 years.
2. Must have completed at least 75 hours total of community service upon submission of application.
3. Must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA at the time of the application deadline AND at the end of the 2017-2018 school year.
4. Should be a responsible, supportive, self-disciplined, positive, and energetic individual who is interested in the welfare of education and in the community.
5. The number of awards is at the sole discretion of the Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. Rho Xi Zeta Chapter and the ZEAL Foundation of Georgia.
6. The scholarship must be used at an accredited college or university in the United States of America and will be made payable to the selected school or student.
7. The Rho Xi Zeta scholarship committee or ZEAL Foundation of Georgia will appoint judges to review the submitted scholarship applications. Finalists will be selected based on the application and attached documents. The scholarship recipients will be chosen and notified.
8. The Rho Xi Zeta scholarship committee or ZEAL Foundation of Georgia reserves the right to conduct an interview of the finalists if deemed necessary.

Please be sure to complete the scholarship application form and include ALL attachments listed below. Failure to adhere to the instructions will result in disqualification of your application.

1. COMPLETED 2018 Lillian Plato Scholarship Award Application
2. An official copy of your high school transcript showing your cumulative GPA
3. Two letters of recommendations:
 - i. **One from a local member of the community or active member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.**
 - ii. **One from a faculty or staff member who can assess your skills.**
4. A 500-800 word scholarship essay (information will be included in application)

Your completed application package should be time stamped no later than **Friday, March 16, 2018 by 11:59 pm online. All applications and supporting documents must be submitted electronically at scholarship@zpb-rhoxizeta.org.**

- ❖ **Your essay will be judged based on the following:**
 - The degree to which the writer establishes a main idea and elaborates with examples, illustrations, and facts or details that are appropriate to the audience.
 - The degree to which the writer's ideas are arranged in a clear order and concessive manner.
 - The degree to which the writer demonstrates control of sentence formation, usage, and mechanics.
